CALL TO ORDER BY COUNCIL PRESIDENT FONTANA

STATEMENT OF PUBLIC NOTICE WAS READ

ROLL CALL - COUNCIL MEMBERS JOE SISCO, MERCEDES GONZALEZ, LOU FONTANA, JOHN VANTUNO AND PAM PORTER WERE PRESENT. MAYOR DARLENE POST, ATTORNEY WILLIAM NORTHGRAVE, AND BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR JOANNE BERGIN WERE PRESENT.

A MOTION TO OPEN TO PUBLIC COMMENT WAS MADE BY GONZALEZ, SECONDED BY VANTUNO AND CARRIED ON A UNANIMOUS "AYE" VOTE.

GALE KOSTER - ZELIFF AVENUE - I LIVE NEAR THE CORNER OF ZELIFF AND MAIN. PARKING ON THE STREET IN THIS AREA CAUSES AN UNSAFE CONDITION. I AM IN FAVOR OF THE ORDINANCE TO RESTRICT PARKING FOR THE 192 FEET.

RONALD FLEET - ZELIFF AVENUE - I ALSO AM IN FAVOR OF THE NO PARKING SIGNS. RESIDENTS FEAR THE DANGER AT THE SCHOOL BUS STOP.NO PARKING IS CRITICAL. THERE IS A REAL DANGER AT THE MAIN STREET INTERSECTION.

GEORGE COLE - ZELIFF AVENUE - THE NO PARKING SIGNS WERE ALWAYS THERE. IT WAS NEVER A PROBLEM. NOW THE STREET IS CLUTTERED WITH CARS. NEAR MISSES ARE BECOMING COMMON. YOU SHOULD REPLACE THE ORIGINAL SIGNS.

AL ALABRAHAM - ZELIFF AVENUE - IT IS IMPOSSIBLE FOR A FIRE TRUCK TO PASS WITH PARKING AND OPPOSING TRAFFIC.

BRIAN LISCIO - PERMIT PARKING WOULD SOLVE THE PROBLEM. PARKING IS TIGHT FOR EVERYONE.

KEITH LISCIO - I OWN A HOME IN THE AREA. TENANTS HAVE NO PARKING AVAILABLE. IT IS A HARDSHIP. I AGREE CHILDREN'S SAFETY IS PARAMOUNT.

ANNA FLEET - ZELIFF AVENUE - SHE DESCRIBED THE PARKING DIFFICULTIES ALONG ZELIFF.

CHIEF DMUCHOWSKI - THE CHIEF EXPLAINED THE HISTORY OF THE SIGNS AND PARKING ORDINANCES IN THE AREA. THE DPW, POLICE AND BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR ALL WORKED ON THE PROBLEM. TEMPORARY SIGNS WERE NOT WORKING.

PORTER - DON'T SOME HOMES HAVE BACK DRIVEWAYS?
