# LITTLE FALLS FIRE DEPARTMENT

**December 11, 2014**

Little Falls Fire Dept. Fire Alarm Maintenance Report 2014

The Little Falls Fire Department responded to a total of 777 alarms and Eagle Rescue Squad responded to a total of 1372 EMS calls for assistance. A total of 2149 emergency calls were handled through the Little Falls Fire Alarm dispatch in addition to the many non emergency business calls for the fire department. The volume of calls handled by the fire alarm dispatch center reaffirms the need to continue this vital service within our department in our continued efforts to save lives, protect property and provide an organized Emergency Incident Command system.

During 2014 the Township of Little Falls experienced the following incidents where the Fire Department worked for an extended time period to mitigate the emergency:

As the Chief of the Fire Department, I was extremely proud and honored to be working with our officers and our members through all of these incidents. The above emergencies are highlighted as the major events throughout the year however our membership is prepared and rise to the occasion whenever called upon.

Department line officers held monthly meetings throughout the year to discuss general operations, policies and procedures and with future development within the department. The Board of Fire Officers held meetings with Department Presidents of each company to review budgetary items which have an impact on the membership throughout the year.



## CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS 2015

- We continue to work at replacing Engine #2 at a cost of \$675,000 (Inclusive of new equipment which is desperately needed.)  
*At this time we are in our 3<sup>rd</sup> year of funds needed to be in place for the purchase of a new engine. Over the past three years repairs have cost over \$25,000 after replacing the motor in 2009/10 at a cost of \$50,000. The apparatus should have been replaced in 2012 and until such time we will continue to put forth unnecessary repair costs.*
- Engine 4 is also due for replacement as it has begun its 24th year of service. Substantial savings can be obtained by combining replacement of Engine 2 and Engine 4 at the same time.
- Secure funding for the replacement of two (2) Township Ambulance units 842 & 843, \$296,000. By purchasing both ambulances we can secure a 12-15% discount for the township.
- Implementation start-up costs of \$95,000 for The Little Falls Fire Department Emergency Medical Service which was adopted by ordinance# 1135 in 2011.  
*Little Falls dispatches an average. 4 ambulance calls per day within the township and we are in grave need for a resolution to the lack of daytime volunteers. This service can provide daily coverage with an average response time of 3-5 minutes should someone be in need of medical attention.*
- Rescue One (Truck) has completed 15 years of service. In 2019, this apparatus will be due for replacement. Accruals for this purchase should begin in 2015 at a rate of \$75,000 per year.
- LOSAP contribution is being requested to increase from 1250.00 to \$1350.00 for qualifying members. This contribution has not been increased since 2008.
- Increase the yearly clothing allowance to \$400.00 for qualifying members for 2015.



- Air-packs / Cylinders and Fill Station (SCBA) replacement \$500,000

*This equipment will need to be taken out of service by December 31, 2015. On 12/5/14 a regional Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) was filed with FEMA in conjunction with Totowa, Woodland Park and the City of Passaic (lead agency). The final resolution on this grant will be known by March 2015. Should it not be awarded, I will need to work closely with the Mayor and Town Council along with the Board of Fire Officers to secure replacement of this personal protective equipment and maintain compliance with the laws and regulations surrounding them.*

- The LFFD dispatch purchase of C.A.D system along with two Z-Tron work dispatch stations- \$48,000.

*This equipment is used for current radio communications and future growth in shared services with neighboring towns. LFFD plays a major role in southern zone dispatch in Passaic County.*

## ACCOMPLISHMENTS 2014

- Continued to work with New Jersey American Water Company for upgrading water supply throughout the Township of Little Falls. The installation of a 12" main on Paterson Ave replaced a previous 8" main. All hydrants on Paterson Avenue have been replaced with additional hydrants added to Morris Canal Rd and Paterson Avenue at the Rt 46 entrance /exit ramp. All hydrants will be equipped with Storz connections.
- Replaced 100 Motorola Minitor IV pagers in May of 20  
*I would like to thank Mayor Post and the Township Committee for their support in securing the funding for this replacement of equipment.*
- Successful completion of the Firefighter One Course offered at Passaic County Public Safety Academy by seven (7) of our members.
- Engine, Ladder Truck and Rescue training was conducted on Company and Department levels to enhance effective and safe fire ground procedures. Department drills also included the utilization of instructors from outside the department. In addition an Officers Training Class was held in January 2014.
- TEEX training was held at Texas A& M College in College Station, Texas

This program was sponsored by NJ Transit and covered Jurisdictional Crisis Incident Management- ICP. I would like to thank all of the attendees who spent time away from their personal lives to attend this program which will benefit our Township should there be a crisis. I would also like to thank Frank Iurato and the staff of the NJ Transit Police for including the members of LFFD for this specialized training. This has been the most advanced level of ICS that any first responder could ask for in setting the stage for a large scale incident.

- Members of Engine Two attended Structural Fire training at the Bergenfield Fire Academy in November 2013. This training covered basic firefighting, vent enter and search training and hose line advancement.
- The RAPID ENTRY SYSTEM, (Knox Box) program has continued to expand on a commercial and residential level. We have increased our participation in this program. This program is a vital role in rapid entry and ensuring the safety for both our firefighters and the residents of the Township of Little Falls.
- As part of Operation Graduation; a joint demonstration with The Little Falls Police and Fire Departments along with the NJ State Police North Star, Medi-Vac helicopter was held on Hopson Avenue for Passaic Valley High School senior students. The demonstration consisted of a reenactment of a severe traffic accident as a result of drunk driving. The students observed the exercise and were reminded of the dangers of drinking and driving.
- Continued the work to address the radio communications system. This includes portable, mobile and base stations located at the various fire companies. We are in the final phase with the installation of new antennas on the cell tower of Great Notch Co #4. All electrical work with back-up generator power has been completed at the radio shed. Radio equipment has been reprogrammed and assigned accordingly. From Jan to June this year, weekly meetings and conference calls had been held along with onsite reviews to complete this project. The overall goal is to implement an effective radio system for Fire/EMS and Police. I would like to extend a special thanks to Dan Stratthaus, Jeff Altonjy and Michael Bolchune for their efforts in completing this project.

- Continued to work closely with the Fire Official, Fire Inspectors and Building Inspector to insure code enforcement for the safety and well being of our residents and firefighters. The new addition of James DiMaria to the Fire Prevention Bureau has complimented our program.
- The implementation of General Orders 14-01 to 14-29 was done in January 2014.
- Successful completion of full OSHA Compliance review for all safety and health standards within our department.
- Completed ISO review of our training records, equipment, call volume, General Orders and preplan procedures. Final rating level is pending.
- Department President Michael Burke in an ongoing effort to help public awareness for The Little Falls Fire Department participated in the following activities:
  - Attended Passaic County Mutual Aid Association meetings
  - Attended North Jersey and Relief Association
  - Attended Little Falls Fire Dept. Officers meetings.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank President Michael Burke and the Executive Committee in establishing the Little Falls Firefighters Association. Meetings were held throughout the year to accomplish this goal and achieve legal status as a registered 5013C entity.

Lastly I would like to thank Michael Burke and the Annual Dinner Committee for their efforts in the expansion and planning of this event.



## GOALS / OBJECTIVES

2015

- Replacement of Engine #2 and #4 - approval of final bond ordinance
- Replacement of Ambulance Units 842 and 843.
- Remodeling and upgrading Fire Alarm Dispatch room.
- Begin implementation of The Little Falls Fire Dept. of Emergency Services
- Begin Accruals for Rescue One replacement in 2019
- Look to increase contributions for Lo-sap and Clothing Allowance.
- Air Pack/Cylinder and Fill Station replacement
- Continue training within our department on the homes being demolished by past flooding. This training provides safe fireground procedures at the time of an emergency.
- Continue with further improvement of water supply with NJ American Water: Next phase to continue the 16" main east on Main Street to connect to Browertown Rd.

In the spring of 2015, NJ American water will be replacing and standardizing all fire hydrants throughout the township.

Improve water supply on Lincoln, First, Second and Third Avenues with a relining program being offered by New Jersey American Water Co.

- 2015 training classes will consist of the following:
  - Fire Alarm Operations- Dispatch class
  - Truck training program
  - Blood-borne Pathogen (offered from Clifton Health Dept)
  - Water rescue/Vehicle Extrication training
  - Drafting Drill and Pump Operations
  - Officers Training Class

The following classes will be offered by LFFD training officer James Hearney:

- Right To Know
  - Hazmat Awareness
  - Fireground Safety Class (in conjunction with a Safety Officers Class)
- Board of Fire Officers meetings will be held for the review and recommended revisions to Township ordinances involving the Little Falls Fire Division. Implement Standard Operating Procedures.
  - Enrollment of six (6) new members of The Little Falls Fire Department in the Firefighter One classes offered at Passaic County Public Safety/Fire Academy to begin in January 2015. The enrollment of two (2) members of LFFD to the Firefighter Two class in February 2015.
  - Continue working with our Mayor, Business Administrator and Town Council members on matters pertaining to the Fire Department budget, expenditures and capital improvements.
  - Continue to work closely with the Fire Official, Fire Inspectors and Building Inspector to insure code enforcement for the safety and well being of our residents and firefighters.
  - Continue our efforts in changing our Township status from Fire Division to Fire Department. This change would allow the Council to become more involved in helping us achieve our goals.
  - A committee has been formed to review and propose revisions of the By-Laws of The Little Falls Fire Department.
  - Continue to maintain full compliance of all OSHA and PEOSH standards and regulations.

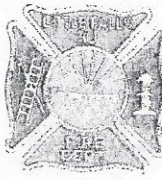

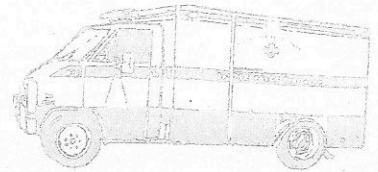
## **1. Summary of Ambulance Services**

A Total of 1,372 ambulance requests were made during the 2014 fire year. Our company responded to a vast number of emergencies. We responded to motor vehicle accidents, roll overs, vehicle entrapments, gas emergencies, elevator entrapments, a wide range of medical emergencies, lift assists, medical transports, trauma incidents, fire standbys, mutual aid calls to our neighboring communities, as well as one mobilization to the City of Passaic as part of a NJ EMS Task Force Strike Team. With all of our responsibilities, we also cover the Passaic Valley High School Home Football games along with Totowa and West Paterson. Our members take pride in the service that we provide to the community. An aspect of our company that stands out is that we have the opportunity to cover some pretty awesome events. This year we were asked to provide coverage at the annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July Fireworks display in Hoboken on the Hudson River. We were also asked to assist Montclair State University EMS with their annual concerts. In previous years we also had the opportunity to go to the Atlantic City Airshow. The events I mentioned are just some of the perks to being a part of this company. I am encouraging the residents of Little Falls to come down to the firehouse and see what we are about. We are here to help our neighbors. In order to maintain our great service, we need more members. Eagle Rescue Squad is actively seeking new volunteers. You will have the opportunity to make a difference in someone's life. Company 1 might be the right opportunity for you. I would also like to point out to anyone who may be interested in the medical field; the experiences you gain here will be with you throughout your entire career.

## **3. Training**

Eagle Rescue Squad has put on 8 new members this year. Of our 8 new members, 5 already had obtained their EMT certification. Two of our members are currently enrolled in the class and should be graduating this month. We also have one member who is registered for the Spring 2015 class. Our members continue to obtain and maintain their EMT and CPR certifications as per the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services. Many of our members have also attended outside classes to maintain their certifications and further their education. Some of our members went on to acquire their firefighter 1, firefighter 2, or other advanced certification.

To prepare for major incidents that may occur in the future, our Assistant Chief this year had the opportunity of training at the TEEX Fire Training Field in College Station, Texas along with other members of our Department. This training provided real life scenarios for our members to work at and created a really challenging environment for them to develop their skills. More members of our company will have an opportunity to attend this training in the coming fire year. Lastly, our company had the opportunity to be a part of a large scale drill in Wayne. Our company worked with the Passaic County Sherriff's Department, Picatinny Arsenal, the FBI, Wayne FD, Wayne PD, and the Wayne First Aid Squad during this drill. To quote Admiral Nimitz "There is no substitute for experience; however, when experience is not readily available, there is no substitute for training." I want to thank our members for being professional and for preparing themselves to handle the next incident whatever it may be.

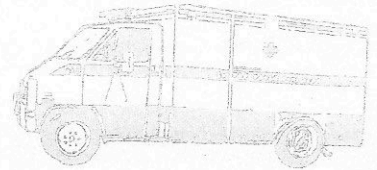
## **4. Recommendations**

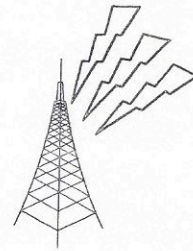

Dear Chief Sweezy,

Please accept the following as the 2014 yearend report for the Township of Little Falls Municipal Fire Alarm System.

Various fire alarm system maintenance tasks were performed throughout the year. These tasks included repainting and refurbishing street boxes, transferring our lines to all of the new poles Public Service has placed throughout the town, and performing regular voltage monitoring of all three circuits.

The Fire Alarm crew has also surveyed and planned two projects for new line. Currently the only single conductor line wire that is still in service is on Long Hill Road south / east of Ridge Road. This would require approximately 3,000 feet of new wire to replace. The second project is to have box 62 - Cedar Grove Road at Charles Street put back in service. This would require 1,000 feet of new wire.

Throughout the year there was an ongoing effort to identify the source of random taps during periods of high wind. The Fire Alarm crew identified a section of cable where Public Service secondary wires were causing the interference. The interference has since been mitigated, and no further random taps have been reported. I am very proud to report that Little Falls Municipal Fire Alarm system was fully operational 365 days of the 2014 fire year.
