APPLYING FOR A PERMIT TO CARRY A HANDGUN

PLEASE PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING TO THE FIREARM INVESTIGATOR:

- 1. One (1) State of New Jersey application for Permit to Carry a Handgun (Form SP642). *It must be double sided and notarized
- 2. Proof of qualification with a certified firearms instructor along with the firearms instructor's proof of certification.
- 3. Consent for Mental Health Search (form: SP066).
- 4. A "Firearms Applicant Reference" questionnaire from EACH of the references listed on the application. *This can be found on the Police Department's website under "File/Document."
- 5. You must submit one (1) of any of the following combinations:
 - Driver's License and Birth Certificate
 - Driver's License and Passport
 - Driver's License and Naturalization Paperwork/Green Card
- 6. A copy of a current utility bill or bank/credit statement in the applicant's name and address as proof of residency. (Account numbers and financial information may be blocked out)
- 7. Two (2) separate money orders. One (1) in the amount of \$150 payable to; "Township of Little Falls." One (1) in the amount of \$50 payable to; "Treasurer, State of New Jersey."
- 8. Two (2) color passport sized photographs.
 - ***ALL APPLICANTS (initial and renewal) must be fingerprinted. Instructions for fingerprinting can be found on our website or can be provided when submitting the application.
 - ***The required written firearms qualification, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 13:54-2.4(B), can be obtained at most firearms ranges in New Jersey. A list is also available on the following website: www.NJSP.ORG public information > firearms information > New Jersey shooting ranges for RPO qualification.

 ***A New Jersey permit to carry is valid for two (2) years from the time of approval.
 - ***If any of the preceding is not complete or incorrect, the application will be returned, and you will have to re-apply.
