## Health Officer's Little Falls February 2023 Report:


- Quality Improvement meetings with Environmental, Administration, Animal Control, Nursing, Health Education and COVID team.

This outreach was held during the Passaic County Clerk event, which helped us meet with many families. We were able to interact with residents, children, and parents. 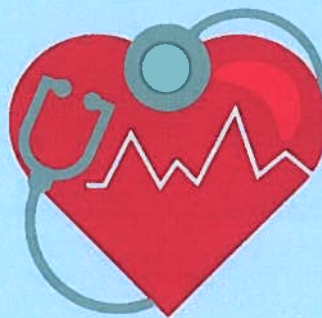
