Evacuate Now!!!!

Based upon updated forecast models, we are expecting significant flooding that will impact the areas affected by the Passaic River. We are asking all residents to evacuate your homes prior to midnight and please continue to monitor conditions and follow all township social media and emergency notifications. Flooding may cause dangers that may prohibit rescues as early as the overnight hours. Residents remain in their homes at their own peril. Please remove all important personal information and keepsakes that cannot be replaced. Temperatures are anticipated to plummet below freezing. Utilities may be turned off by the utility companies.

Designated Parking Areas:

- Vehicles can be parked in any municipal lot, St Agnes, or public roadway not subject to flooding.

Shelters:

- The Civic Center will be opened as an Emergency Shelter. Residents will be transported if necessary. No pets will be permitted.
- Residents can use this location if they do not have friends or family able to accommodate them.

Utilities:

- We are recommending that you take precautions with all utilities prior to evacuation. Fire Dept. Personnel can assist evacuating residents with shutting off electric and gas.

Additional Information:

- The stormwater pumps will remain on until such a time as they are futile.
- Sand and sandbags are available at the intersection of Parkway and West End Ave near Main Street as well as the DPW yard.
