**When you hear sirens, or any of the above notifiers, we are at THE EVACUATION ACTION STAGE:**

RESIDENTS **MUST EVACUATE** AT THIS TIME. If you need transportation to the shelter, buses will be in the area.

No pets will be allowed in shelter. (not applicable to service dogs with proper documentation)

Pets with ID tags and in cages will be kept outside the shelter under a tent.
